ST. LOUIS – The Sheldon presents Kim Massie: “Rollin’ On the River,” Tuesday and Wednesday, November 10 and 11 at 10 a.m. in the perfect acoustics of the Sheldon Concert Hall. Coffee and pastries are served, starting at 9 a.m., in the beautiful Louis Spiering room.

St. Louis music icon Kim Massie is one of St. Louis’ most active and recognizable vocalists in the Midwest. With a repertoire, that includes “Respect,” “At Last” and more, Massie puts her own sassy spin on classic favorites. In this high-energy jazz, soul and R&B show, Massie celebrates the music of St. Louis, with hits by Chuck Berry, Tina Turner and more! She recently released her first professionally recorded album of original compositions, *Inspired*.

Kim Massie’s ability to sing not only the blues but rock, pop, country, gospel and R&B has earned her two Best Female Vocalist of the Year Awards from the *Riverfront Times*, as well as a Grand Center Visionary Award in 2005 and a starring role in a St. Louis Black Repertory production of “Ain’t Nothin’ But The Blues.” Massie has shared the stage with artists such as Cyndi Lauper, India Arie, Nelly and Chuck Berry. She has performed for organizations such as Major League Baseball, Purina and Boeing, and at esteemed venues and events such as the Missouri History Museum, Big Muddy Blues Festival, Davenport Blues Festival, Emerald City Blues Festival and the Blues Rising Festival. When Massie is not on tour or playing local events, she can be found with her band, the Solid Senders, at her favorite venue, Beale on Broadway in St. Louis.
