## **ART OF TIME ENSEMBLE BRINGS “SGT. PEPPER’S LONELY HEARTS CLUB BAND” TO THE SHELDON**

ST. LOUIS – The Sheldon presents **Art of Time Ensemble: *Sgt. Pepper’s Lonely Hearts Club Band* with Andrew Burashko, artistic director**, Monday, October 17 at 8 p.m. in the perfect acoustics of the Sheldon Concert Hall. Artistic Director Andrew Burashko formed Art of Time Ensemble in 1998 with the support of a small group of like-minded musicians and prominent figures in dance, theatre and other art forms, beginning with concerts to small-but-enthusiastic audiences in Toronto’s cultural scene. Today, Art of Time works with the best Canadian artists in the performing arts, film and literature, and noteworthy international musicians.

This tribute to the classic Beatles album features vocalists Steven Page of Barenaked Ladies, Craig Northey, Wesley Stace (AKA John Wesley Harding) of NPR’s *Cabinet of Wonders* and Andy Maize.

Art of Time presents an annual subscription season at Toronto’s Harbourfront Centre Theatre, and regularly appears as part of the Royal Conservatory of Music performance season at Toronto’s Koerner Hall. The company is invited to perform at festivals and events across Canada, including Music in the Morning in Vancouver, the Banff Centre, Chamberfest and the National Arts Centre in Ottawa. Art of Time also tours Canada, having taken American jazz chanteuse Madeleine Peyroux and Canadian pop stars Steven Page and Sarah Slean out on the road with the Ensemble. Art of Time embarked on a 12-city tour of the United States in November 2015, and will return for a 13-city engagement in the fall of 2016.
