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## MARC COHN CELEBRATES THE 25<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF HIS DEBUT ALBUM ON SHELDON FOLK SERIES

ST. LOUIS – The Sheldon presents **Marc Cohn**, Friday, November 18 at 8 p.m. in the perfect acoustics of the Sheldon Concert Hall. Celebrating the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his platinum-selling debut album, Marc Cohn and his all-star band will perform his Grammy-winning, self-titled record in its entirety in an intimate concert experience. After solidifying his place as one of this generation’s most compelling singer/songwriters with his soulful ballad “Walking in Memphis,” Cohn then released two more albums in the 1990s, prompting *Time* magazine to call him “one of the most honest, emotional voices we need in this decade.”

Bonnie Raitt, James Taylor, David Crosby, Graham Nash and Patty Griffin all made guest appearances on Cohn’s early records for Atlantic, as his reputation as an artist and performer continued to grow. In 1998, Cohn took a decade-long sabbatical from recording, ending in 2007 with the release of *Join the Parade*, followed by over 150 shows across the country. Inspired by the horrific events following Hurricane Katrina and his own near fatal shooting just weeks before, *Join the Parade* is his most critically acclaimed record to date. In 2010, Cohn returned with *Listening Booth: 1970*, a collection of cover songs that were originally released during the titular year. In addition to crossing genres from rock and soul to folk and pop, it features vocal performances from India Arie, Jim Lauderdale, Aimee Mann and Kristina Train. In March 2016, in celebration of the 25th anniversary of his debut album, Cohn proudly released *Careful What you Dream: Lost Songs and Rarities* and the bonus album, *Evolution of a Record*, featuring never-before-heard songs and demos dating back to years before his debut album and the Grammy Award that followed.
