CORRECTED TITLE FOR FALL 2017 CARL SAFE EXHIBITION AT THE SHELDON

ST. LOUIS, MO – The title for the previously announced exhibit at the Sheldon Art Galleries, featuring the work of Washington University professor emeritus Carl Safe, has changed to better reflect the content of the exhibition. Please note the updated title below. The exhibit opens on October 6, 2017 from 5-7 p.m.

The career of Carl Safe, Professor Emeritus in the Department of Architecture, Sam Fox School of Design and Art at Washington University in St. Louis, is celebrated in this overview exhibit of Safe's furniture and architectural designs and photographs. Safe has been a member of the faculty there since 1970, where he has taught design studios and support courses. In addition to his status as Professor Emeritus, Safe is Principal at Carl Safe Design Consultants.

The not-for-profit Sheldon Art Galleries exhibits works by local, national and international artists in all media. Over 6,000 square feet of the galleries' spaces on the 2nd floor are permanently devoted to rotating exhibits of photography, architecture, music art and history and children's art. A sculpture garden, seen from both the atrium lobby and the connecting glass bridge, features periodic rotations and installations, and the Nancy Spirtas Kranzberg Gallery on the lower level features art of all media. The Sheldon actively supports the work of St. Louis artists in all mediums and features a dedicated gallery with museum-quality exhibits by St. Louis artists, past and present.
