## **DAN RUBRIGHT PROMISES ENERGIZING MORNING OF JAZZ ON SHELDON MATINEE SERIES**

ST. LOUIS – The Sheldon presents **Dan Rubright & Friends**, Saturday, April 6, 2019 at 11a.m. in the perfect acoustics of the Sheldon Concert Hall. Composer and jazz guitarist Dan Rubright is joined by top St. Louis artists Steve Davis, drums; Paul DeMarinis, tenor and soprano saxophones; Chris Turnbaugh, bass; and Nick Schlueter, piano to perform eclectic, contemporary compositions by Rubright, which draw from jazz, world and pop influences. Don't miss this energetic show loaded with soaring hooks and surprises for music fans of all ages!

Dan Rubright is a guitarist, composer and bandleader based in St. Louis. He discovered his love of composing from an early age and has continued writing for diverse projects throughout his career. He attended the University of Cincinnati College Conservatory of Music and Webster University where he received B.M. and M.M. degrees in jazz performance, graduating with honors. He joined the jazz faculty at Webster University where he taught jazz guitar and various courses including commercial composition, jazz theory, songwriting and arranging.

Rubright currently leads two of his own groups which feature his original compositions: The WirePilots and, most recently, The Dan Rubright Group (DRG). DRG recently toured to Colorado and released its debut album in November 2018. Rubright has worked as an in-demand guitarist for a variety of groups including the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra, the Fabulous Fox Theatre, the Muny, Opera Theatre of Saint Louis, The Erin Bode Group and with artists such as Willie Akins, Denise Thimes, Paul DeMarinis, Carolbeth True, Ptah Williams, Chris Cheek, Peter Mayer and Steve Davis.
