TIM SCHALL TO PERFORM CLASSIC CINEMATIC SONGS AT SHELDON COFFEE CONCERT

Coffee and pastries are served, starting at 9 a.m., in the beautiful Louis Spiering Room. Vocalist Tim Schall takes listeners back to those magic moments, sitting in a darkened theatre, hearing these cinematic masterpieces for the first time! Enjoy some of the greatest songs from Hollywood’s most beloved films of all time by songwriters such as Henry Mancini, Andrew Lloyd Webber, Lerner & Lowe, Rodgers & Hammerstein and Irving Berlin.

Singer and actor Tim Schall, known for his recent performances at Stages St. Louis, Union Avenue Opera and the Spotlight Theater, received his B.A. in Theater Arts from St. Louis University and is a member of AEA/AGMA. A talented tenor, Schall has been called a “consummate cabaret performer” by *Cabaret Scenes Magazine*. He is the producer of The St. Louis Cabaret Conference, one of the nation’s largest professional development programs in cabaret performance, and is the Executive Director of The Cabaret Project of St. Louis. He is also a teacher and offers performance classes for singers.

Schall’s one-person shows have been featured on many other stages in St. Louis, along with appearances in Chicago, Boston and Santa Fe. A veteran actor, he was recently nominated for a St. Louis Theater Circle Award as Outstanding Supporting Actor for his performance in *The Normal Heart*. He has appeared with multiple theaters in St. Louis and Chicago, including The Muny, Stages St. Louis, The Black Rep, Mustard Seed Theater, New Jewish Theater, Pegasus Players, Chicago Opera Theater, both the Chicago and St. Louis Symphony Choruses, as a soloist with Webster University’s Opera Scenes evening in 2015. He is a Missouri Arts Council Touring Artist and has performed and taught song performance workshops throughout the state.
