Similarly, the City of Black & White Revisited Tour will feature Kearney’s extensive, award-winning catalog in a rare intimate acoustic performance.

A native of Eugene, OR, Mat Kearney has been a traveling songwriter for more than a decade, releasing three Top 20 albums along the way. The sound he helped introduce with his major-label debut, 2006’s *Nothing Left to Lose* — a record that combined the bright sounds of pop music with the with darker, harder-hitting influence of hip-hop — has since become one of the most common genres of the 21st century, with chart-topping artists like Ed Sheeran and Twenty One Pilots following in his footsteps.
